The UCLA Center for Health Policy Research (Center) has an outstanding career opportunity for a Research Associate (RA). The Center is one of the nation's leading health policy research centers and the premier source of health policy information for California. Established in 1994, the Center is based in the School of Public Health and affiliated with the School of Public Affairs.

The RA, working with program/project directors, managers and administrators, will assist with administrative and research functions of the California Health Interview Survey (CHIS), the largest state telephone health survey in the country. CHIS is conducted with adults, parents of young children and with adolescents. CHIS has been conducted every other year since 2001. Specific responsibilities include: coordinating CHIS questionnaire development activities; conducting research and providing support for a variety of survey activities related to questionnaire development, implementation, analysis, and dissemination of data from CHIS; determining research activities and best course of action for accomplishing objectives, as well as, analysis of project related data and findings, interpreting results of findings and drafting summary reports and papers.
